

MATERIALS

Bracelett, 7.5 inch (19 cm) without clasp

7 g Super8, Metallic Rose

6.5 g 11/0 Seed Beads, #4221 Light Pewter (A)

1.5 g 11/0 Seed Beads, #4220 Eggplant (B)

1.5 g 15/0 Seed Beads, #4221 Light Pewter

Multi Strand Clasp (approx. 18 mm), FireLine 6 lb smoke, Needle size 11

New bead: Super8



The most delicate version of a double hole bead. Small size of approx 2,2 x 4,7mm, slim waist, in the shape of an 8. Many of the classical stitches for double hole beads work for this one too, with a more graceful appearance.

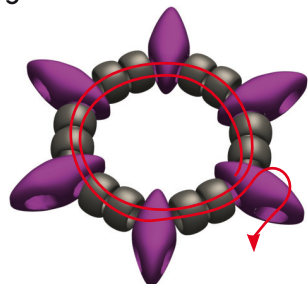

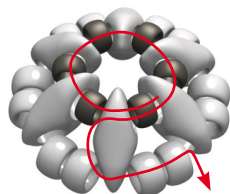

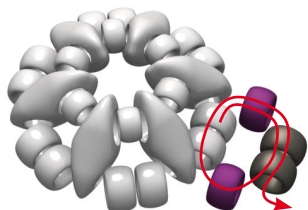

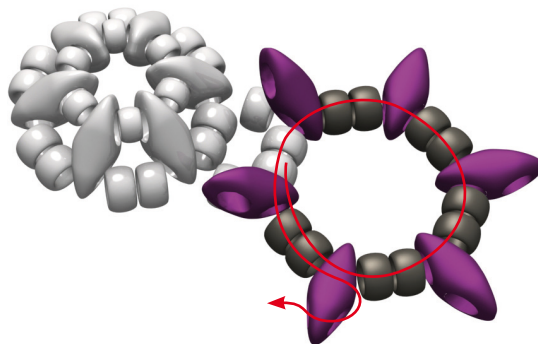

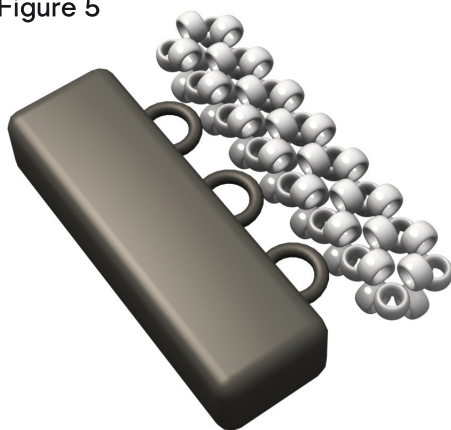

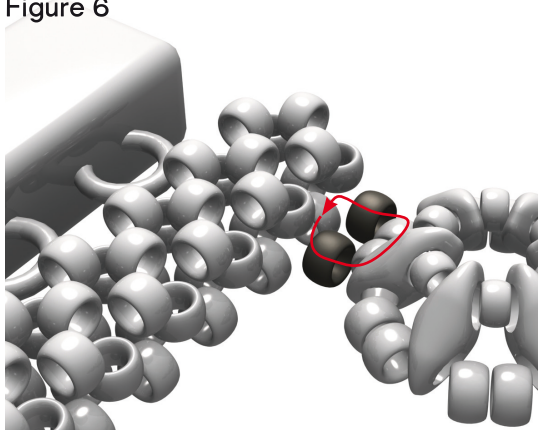

Pick up 1x Super8 and 2x 11/0 A seed beads and repeat this five more times. Now you have 18 beads on your needle. Close them to get a base circle und stitch again through all 18 and some more beads. Stitch forward through the second hole of a Super8.

Figure 2

Pick up 1x 15/0 seed bead and stitch through the second hole of the next Super8. Repeat this five more times. Stitch through the first hole of a Super8 and forward through the following two 11/0 seed beads, added in figure 1.

Figure 3

Pick up 1x 11/0 B seed bead, 2x 11/0 A seed beads and 1x 11/0 B seed bead and stitch through the pair of 11/0 your needle is coming out of. Stitch forward through the first three added 11/0 seed beads.

Figure 4

Pick up 1x Super8 and 2x 11/0 A seed beads and repeat this four more times. Pick up 1x Super 8. Now you have 16 beads on your needle. Stitch through the pair of 11/0 A seed beads, added in figure 3. This is your new base circle.

Repeat the steps of figure 2 to 4 till your strand has got 14 Elements. Be aware that all connections are at the same positions. Work two more strands the same way.

Without figure

Work two 7 units long Cubic-Right-Angle-Wave (CRAW) stripes of 11/0 A seed beads.

Figure 5

Sew on the two parts of the clasp to each middle of the CRAW-stripes.

Figure 6

Sew on the first strip to the CRAW-stripe as you connected the elements. Sew on the second strip to the middle of the CRAW-stripe and the last one to the bead at the other end. Repeat this with the other ends and the other CRAW-stripe.
